Roster & seats

Invite and manage students and control who holds an active seat.

Assign work

Set specific Reading, Listening, Speaking or Writing tasks and homework with due dates.

Monitor progress

Track who is practicing, their bands, section patterns, and weak areas.

Export reports

Download progress summaries for the program, parents, or your records.

The complete 2026 TOEFL, not last year's test

In January 2026 ETS redesigned the TOEFL: a new 1 to 6 band scale, a shorter multistage adaptive format, and brand-new task types. Most books and apps still teach the old test. Five out of seven sentences were repeated with perfect word accuracy; only minor omissions in Q3 and Q7 prevented a full score.

Fluency & Pace 4 / 6
Speech was generally fluent and confident, though the hesitation marker 'hmm' at the start of Q7 indicates a moment of lost tracking.

Intelligibility 4 / 6
ASR intelligibility at 75% suggests generally clear pronunciation with some imprecision that occasionally reduced clarity for automated recognition.

STRENGTHS
The student demonstrated strong listening retention, reproducing five sentences with complete accuracy including longer, more complex items like Q2, Q4, Q5, and Q6. Meaning was consistently preserved across all responses, showing solid comprehension and short-term verbal memory. Capitalization and stress choices in Q1 suggest confident, natural delivery.

HOW TO IMPROVE
In Q7, the student dropped the opening phrase 'With practice,' which changed the sentence structure; practicing full sentence retention from start to finish — especially the first few words — would help. In Q3, the plural 'tasks' was reduced to singular 'task,' a small but scorable error that can be avoided by listening carefully to word endings. Working on sustaining attention to function words and sentence boundaries at the beginning of prompts will push accuracy toward a consistent band 5.

Q3 Target: Start by prioritizing your most important tasks.
You said: Start by prioritizing your most important task.
One word error 'tasks' → 'task'; minor deviation but meaning is slightly altered — scores 4. **86%**

Q4 Target: Avoid distractions that reduce your concentration.
You said: Avoid distractions that reduce your concentration.
Exact repetition, fully intelligible — scores 5. **100%**

How managed seats work

Institutions license PrepDrills in bulk through managed seats, not license codes handed to students. PrepDrills adds a fixed pool of seats to your teacher workspace. One seat gives one student full institutional access at a time, and a seat can be reassigned as your cohort changes.

Your seat pool and term appear in the teacher dashboard.
- 2 Teacher invites**
An invitation reserves a seat for the student's email.
- 3 Student accepts**
The learner connects an account and gets full access.
- 4 Teacher manages**
A seat can be revoked and reassigned to another student.

What one seat means

- One active student at a time, with full institutional access
- No student payment and no credit card, the institution holds the license
- Teacher visibility while the student is on that seat

What reassignment means

- A revoked seat returns to your available balance
- The seat can be granted to another student in your institution
- Seats stay within your institution, they do not transfer out
